Gasunie intends to develop Exit 3 to connect to UK stores

1. Rotterdam is set to become the CO₂ hub of Northwest Europe
2. UK storage and EU volumes are complementary
3. A new connection to the UK is both logical and technically feasible
4. Policy is now the decisive factor
5. This calls for an explicit NL–UK partnership model

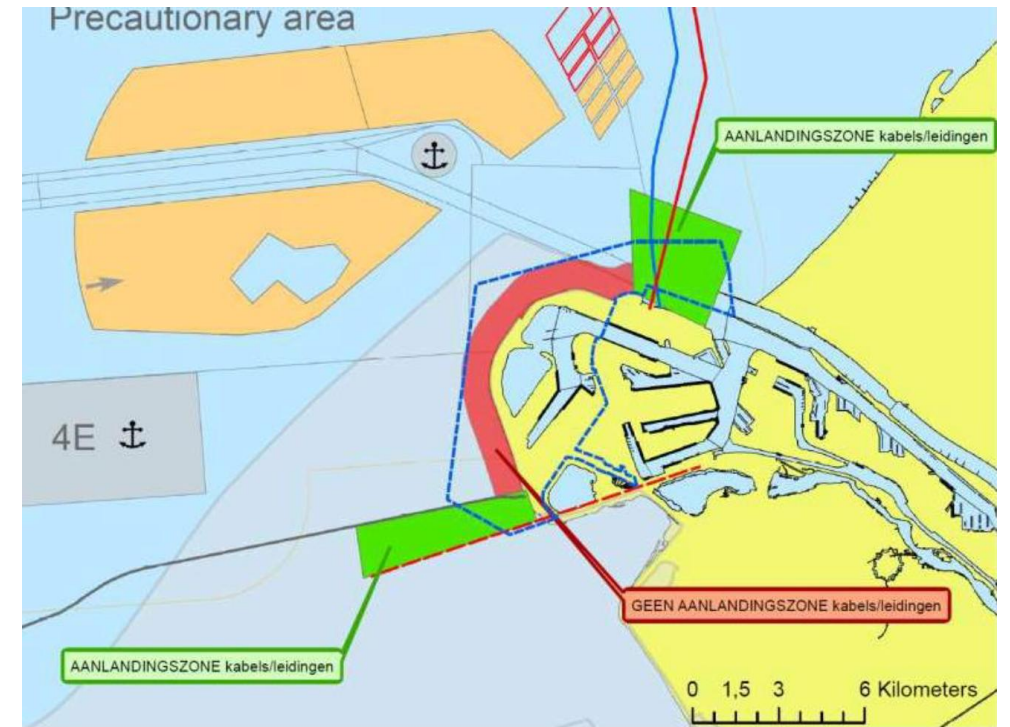


Figure 1: The Maasvlakte landfall areas, shown in green, could both serve as potential starting points for Exit 3.
